



Privacy Policy

1. General

iVisionWeb, LLC ("iVisionWeb") is committed to respecting your online privacy and recognizes your need for appropriate protection and management of any personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") you share with us. This Privacy Policy has been established so that you can understand the care with which we intend to treat your Personal Information. iVisionWeb will make every effort to ensure that our activities keep within the spirit of this Privacy Policy. Please note that by visiting ivationweb.com and ivationhosting.com, or any derivative thereof, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

2. Information Collection and Usage Details

Examples of the information we may collect and analyze from time to time include the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet; login; password; computer and connection information such as browser type and version, operating system, and platform; the full Uniform Resource Locator (URL) clickstream to, through, and from our website, including date and time; and cookie number. During some visits we may use software tools such as (but not limited to) JavaScript to measure and collect session information, including page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page.

This type of information collected by iVisionWeb will be used to enhance the performance of our website, or used as an aid to investigate possible violations of any (or all) of the policies listed at <http://www.ivationweb.com/policies>. iVisionWeb will never share your information with any third-parties, except as required or permitted by applicable law or legal process.

3. Cookies

Cookies are small bits of data that certain websites write to your computer's hard drive when you visit such sites. A cookie file can contain information, such as a user identification code, that the site uses to track the pages you have visited. iVisionWeb sometimes utilizes cookies to facilitate data entry on administrative back-end pages, such as (but not limited to) a username identifier.

Most website browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually change your browser settings to display a warning before accepting a cookie, or to refuse all cookies. However, if you choose to disable the receipt of cookies from our website, you may not be able to use certain features of the site.

4. Account Information

If you purchase something from iVisionWeb, such as a hosting plan service, we will require appropriate information in order to complete the transaction. Depending upon the method of payment that you select and your location, the required information may vary. iVisionWeb may require information such as (but not limited to):

- » Your name
- » Billing Address
- » Shipping Address
- » E-mail Address
- » Credit Card Number (with expiration date and security code)

iVisionWeb makes sure to safeguard this and other information by using methods of encryption (usually SSL, or Secure Sockets Layer) to transmit your information, which renders your information unreadable by any outsider trying to intercept it.

5. Other Information Collection Specifics

iVisionWeb may also request your e-mail address or mailing address for the purposes of conducting a survey, adding you to our company mailing list, or by your request to have someone contact you for additional information. Whenever we request the identity of a visitor, we will clearly indicate the purpose of the inquiry before the information is requested. We maintain a strict "No Spam" policy that means we do not intend to sell, rent, or otherwise give your e-mail address to a third-party without your consent.

In addition, iVisionWeb will not send you e-mail that you have not agreed to receive, with the exception of pertinent information related to your account. If you wish to have specific communications with a



member of the iVisionWeb staff, you may be required to provide specific information that will be routed to the appropriate contact.

iVisionWeb may, without your consent, disclose any of your Personal Information or any of its log file information when required by law or in the good-faith belief that such actions are required to:

- » Conform to the edicts of the law or comply with a legal process served on iVisionWeb.
- » Protect and defend the rights or property of iVisionWeb, or visitors of iVisionWeb.
- » Identify persons who may be violating the law, the legal notice, or the rights of third parties.
- » Cooperate with the investigations of purported unlawful activities.

iVisionWeb takes appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. We restrict access to your personally identifying information to employees who need to know that information in order to operate, develop or improve our services. In addition, iVisionWeb is not responsible for any breach of security or for any actions of any third parties that receive the information.

iVisionWeb may also provide "links" to a wide variety of other web sites on the Internet. We are not responsible for their Privacy Policies or how those web sites manage information about their users. We strongly urge you to check with those web sites to determine their privacy policy.
